### 1) THE PREACHER

- i) <u>HIS DEVOTIONAL LIFE</u> Word and Prayer
- ii) <u>HIS PERSONAL LIFE</u> Relationships, Spouse, opposite sex. "We cannot separate what we say with what we are."
- iii) <u>HIS PROFESSIONAL LIFE</u> Pay bills? Tell the truth? Pulpit convictions fleshed out? Monday and Sunday (Safe in the Pulpit).
- iv) <u>HIS EXAMPLE</u> Personal witnessing; 2<sup>nd</sup> mile.

- 2) PREPARE THE CHURCH Begin with Pastor's attitude.
  - <u>Prayer Groups</u> 10 X 10 = 100 minutes per week.
  - <u>Vision for the lost</u> When was the last Evangelistic event?
  - Training Equipping the Saints in
    - Counseling
    - Soul Winning
    - Discipleship

- The dynamics of Spiritual Growth Our church calendars reflect this dynamic.
- 3) PREPARE TO PREACH Sermons are not speeches for all occasions!
  - A PRIORITY How long in study my head or my heart.
  - <u>A PLACE TO STUDY</u> Any place, but alone with no interruptions.
  - PROTECT YOUR STUDY TIME Secretary, Spouse.

### 4) PREPARING THE MESSAGE – (1 Cor 14:3)

- a) <u>Wait</u> on God "Lord Sunday, what do the people need"
- b) Read the Word, text, subject research, illustrations, quotes
- <u>Spurgeon</u> "When you find your text wherever it is, just go cross country to Jesus. (Rev 19:10)

Our primary task in preaching – lead people to <u>think about</u> <u>their relationship</u> with Jesus Christ.

# 5) PREPARE FOR RESPONSE – arise out of the message.

- Have a goal in mind for hearers to respond to What I am exhorting my hearers to do.
- Clarity To Christ
- <u>Urgency</u> "Last Chance" Dying man to dying men"

Integrity – No tricks, manipulation. What's at stake?
 your reputation, and the name of Jesus.

Dr Torrey - "I'm not a Christian, but I am sound and upright. I would like to know what you have against me." – "I charge you, sir with treason against heavens King" - It's not our Gospel but His.

### 7) THE HOLY SPIRIT – (John 12:32; 1Cor 12:3)

January 1930, Walter Vivian CBS – checking equipment installed to carry the message of King George V to the British Navy around the world – Vivian discovered a break in the wires – there was no time for it to be repaired – grouping two segments of the wire – each hand – became a conductor through which 220 VOLTS of electricity passed, his burned hand became the transmitter for the King's message.
