THE PASTOR / EVANGELIST

By example, by emphasis, by equipping 11 Timothy 4: 1-5

Timothy was pastoring in Ephesus and Paul was exhorting him that his ministry should be evangelistic in nature.

1. Preach <u>Conscientiously</u> (verse 1)

Preach in view of:

- God's <u>Presence</u> (verse 1a)
- God's **Pronouncement** (verse 1b)
- 2. Preach Continuously (verse 2)
 - Preach continuously fulfilling the <u>task</u> (verse 2a)
 - Preach continuously understanding the <u>time</u> (verse 2b)
- 3. Preach Comprehensively (verse2)
 - i. The right tone

Negative (reproof and rebuke)

Positive (exhortation and appeal)

- "Afflict the comfortable and comfort the afflicted"
 - ii. With the right teaching

4. Preach <u>correctly</u> (verses 3 & 4)

- a. Because people lack the <u>endurance</u> for sound <u>doctrine</u>
- b. When people <u>lust</u> for entertainment in accordance with their <u>selfish</u> desires
- 5. Preach completely (verse 5)

Through:

- Thoughtful <u>evaluation</u> ("sober, self-controlled, stable)
- Tremendous endurance
- Tireless <u>evangelism</u>
- Total <u>effort</u> ("fulfil your ministry") -develop to the full
