New Translations

This has been a very fruitful year for BLI regarding new translations of the commentaries into other languages. These are some things the Lord has enabled us to

accomplish this year:

• to complete the translations of Romans, The Gospel of John and I, II and III John into Chinese (Mandarin) and add more commentaries to the Pakistan and Indian languages

• to initiate translations of Romans and John commentaries into the Hungarian and Romanian languages

• to continue translations in Spanish and Arabic. Please pray that God will open doors for these to proceed quickly. Living in Texas, it seems strange that it has been so difficult to find Spanish translators but that has been our experience.

• soon to be added to the website are John in Turkish and Romans in Farsi (Iran).

These translations are very expensive and time consuming! It also involves a spiritual battle because Satan does not want God's word to be available to people. Please pray for resources and accurate translations! Pray that God will continue to lead and guide us and that we will be sensitive to Him. We know that our God is in control and He will take care of Satan and any other obstacles to His will.

Pastor's Conference In Togo, West Africa

BLI sponsored a Pastor's Conference in Togo, West Africa in August of 2008. We had recently completed the translation of my commentary on the book of Romans into French, the main language of Togo. The Togo Baptist Convention invited me to come and teach Romans and distribute the new Computer Bible Commentary CD-Rom. The CD includes the French translation of Romans and I, II and III John. Initially 500 pastors were expected to attend the conference but it quickly expanded to 4,000 participants! We rented the largest meeting hall in the

capital city (Lome) of Togo.

Togo received nine inches of rain just two days before Peggy and I arrived in Lome. This caused so much flooding that nine of the eleven bridges which connected the northern part of the country to Lome were destroyed. It was the worst flooding that they have had in many years. Over 10,000 people were forced from their



Bob, Pastor Kadera (President of Togo Baptist Convention), and Deacon.

Many of the homes were completely destroyed. Because of the problems caused by the flood only 1,700 pastors were able to attend the conference. However, the spirits of those present were not dampened in any way! We experienced these beautiful people worshiping the Lord in their own special way and it was very inspiring.

I was able to teach hermeneutical principles using Romans as an example. The conference was video taped and will soon be available on our free website: freebiblecommentary.org.

> As a result of this conference a three year cycle of translation work has begun. This will enable us to have nine more volumes of my commentaries translated into French. This is very exciting for the pastors and teachers because there are not too many Bible study resources available in French. Please pray for these translators. They are also pastors in local churches and may also have a secular job. Their dedication to the Lord is admirable.

National-to-national Evangelism

As you know BLI contributes to the National-to-National Evangelism projects which are conducted by International Commission of Lewisville, Texas (this is the group that we go with on partnership mission trips). The N-2-N projects do not involve U.S. team members. The nationals are responsible for hosting and enlisting teams. The teams come from within the borders of the country or from neighboring countries, thereby minimizing or eliminating language barriers. Many of these countries do not allow Americans due to political barriers. These projects are less expensive than church-

to-church partnerships involving U.S. teams. This year we sponsored three N2N projects: Botswana, Philippines and Mozambique. We are waiting for the results but usually about 1,400 people trust the Lord during one of these missions. They are hoping for 5,000 to be saved in Mozambique. It is exciting because we know the new believers will be discipled and incorporated into the local church. For more information about International Commission see their website: www.IC-world.org.
